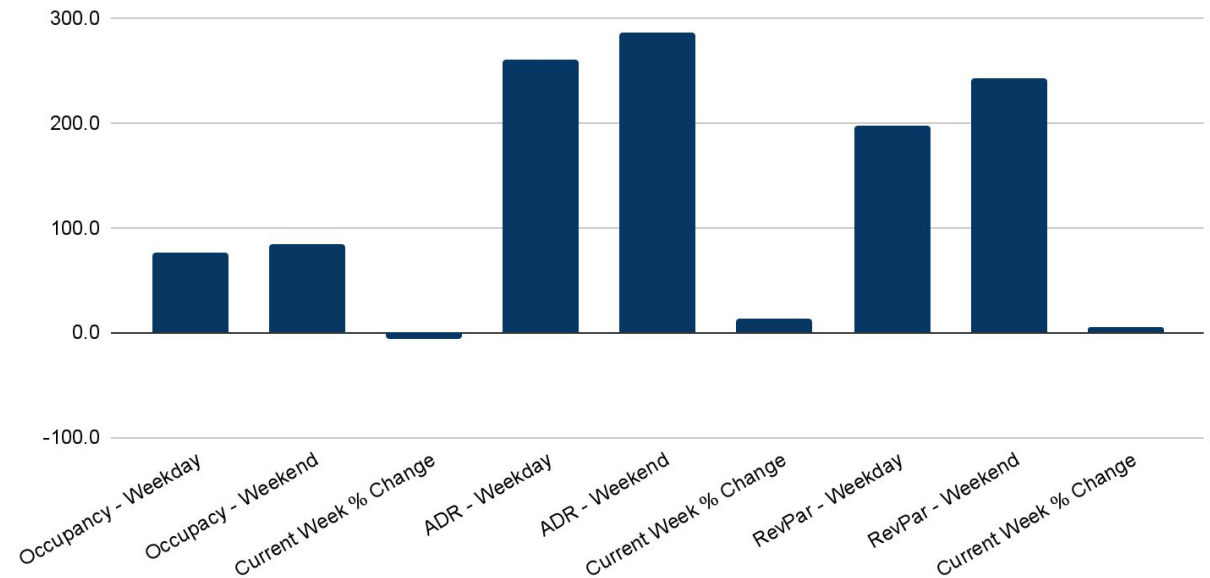
STR Summary BC & Regions

July 31 - August 6, 2022

- British Columbia had a **75.7%** occupancy from Sunday-Thursday and a **84.7%** occupancy during the weekend, down **-6.8%** compared to the same week in 2019.
- British Columbia had an ADR of **\$260.35** from Sunday-Thursday and an ADR of **\$287.03** during the weekend, up **13.7%** compared to the same week in 2019.
- British Columbia had a RevPAR of **\$197.13** from Sunday-Thursday and a RevPAR of **\$243.10** during the weekend, up **6.0%** compared to the same week in 2019.

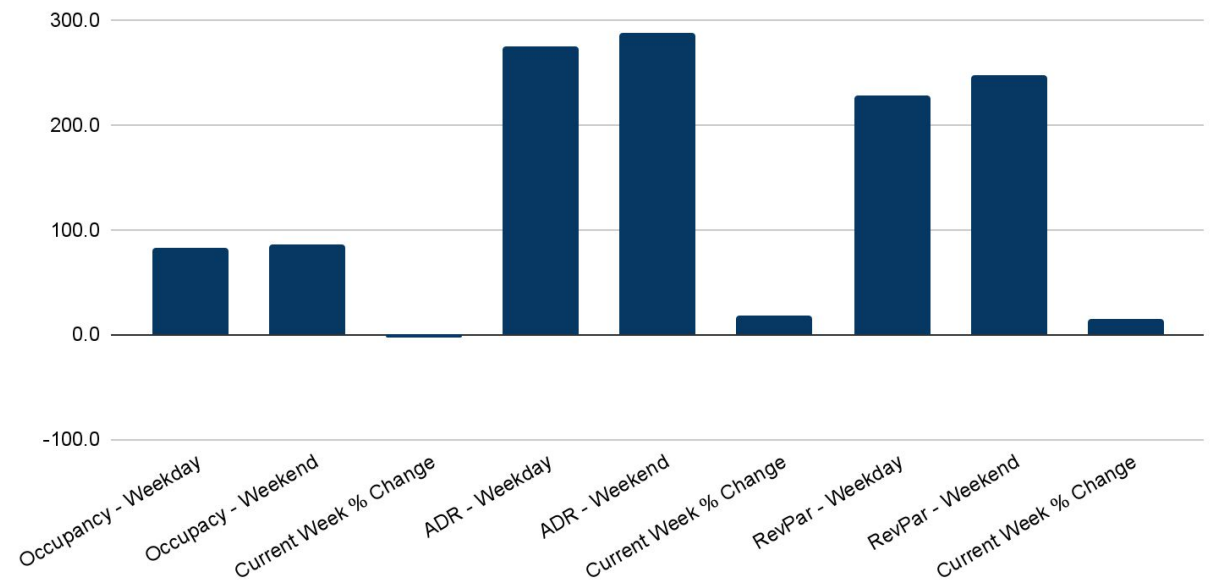
STR Summary BC & Regions

August 7 - August 13, 2022

- British Columbia had a **82.8%** occupancy from Sunday-Thursday and a **86.1%** occupancy during the weekend, down **-3.2%** compared to the same week in 2019.
- British Columbia had an ADR of **\$275.53** from Sunday-Thursday and an ADR of **\$287.49** during the weekend, up **18.6%** compared to the same week in 2019.
- British Columbia had a RevPAR of **\$228.02** from Sunday-Thursday and a RevPAR of **\$247.41** during the weekend, up **14.8%** compared to the same week in 2019.

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Glossary

- **Occupancy:** Calculated by the number of occupied rooms divided by the number of available rooms that physically exist in a hotel
- **Average Daily Rate (ADR):** Represents the average rental income per paid occupied room in a given time period, however, ADR itself cannot be used to measure a hotel's performance
- **Revenue per Available Room (RevPAR):** Calculated by multiplying a hotel's ADR by its occupancy rate, an increase in RevPAR most likely indicates an improvement in occupancy rate and can be used to measure a hotel's performance
